Gatwick Airport Overview

London Gatwick International Airport is the second largest airport in the UK and the seventh busiest international airport in the world. Around 90 airlines operate from Gatwick's two terminals, serving around 230 destinations. The airport is located 45 kilometres north of Brighton and can be reached in half an hour by either road or rail (a railway station is located inside the airport terminal). There is also a half hourly

Transport links between Gatwick and Brighton

By Train: The railway station is located inside the airport terminal with a regular direct service to Brighton. Journey time is 30 minutes. Costs start at £9.00.

By Coach: National Express Coaches offer a half hourly direct service to Brighton. Journey time is 45 minutes. Costs £7.00

By Car: The M23, which is the main route into Brighton, is located adjacent to the airport. Journey time is 40 minutes. Private car hire costs from £35.00

London Heathrow Airport has more international connections than any other airport in the world. It is 90 minutes drive from Brighton using the motorway, or just under two hours using underground train to London Victoria railway station, and the fast express train service to Brighton.
