**1. Webinars in Brazilian Chapters –**

## 2. Meeting of ISPE Brazilian Chapter in BRAZIL

- ✓ Two major congresses offered us opportunities to incorporate the meeting of the Brazilian international chapter. Brazilian Congress of Hospital Pharmacy (May 2019) and Congress of Pharmacists of São Paulo (October 2019).
- ✓ The **Brazilian Congress of Hospital Pharmacy** is attended by 3,000 participants including foreign guests. The first meeting of the Brazilian International Chapter of ISPE will take place on Saturday, May 25. For this first event, we were thinking in ISPE Brazilian chapter to the participants, with Dra. Maribel Salas presenting part of her research in Latin America and Africa. We can also organize a roundtable of Available data sources for Drug utilization research (DUR) with participation of Dra. Monique Elsevier and other recognized researchers (**Appendix 1**). The Congress will finance the costs of Prof. Monique Elsevier and we'll request funds to sponsor Dra. Maribel Salas.
- ✓ The second congress that offered us the possibility of a meeting of the Brazilian International Chapter of ISPE is the Meeting of Pharmacists in São Paulo, which attracts approximately 4,000 participants from all areas of pharmacy. The president of this congress propose three periods to include our program. The final program is under discussion with members of the chapter.
