

***Statement on the March for Science April 22, 2017***

Whereas the International Society for Pharmacoepidemiology (ISPE) is dedicated to advancing the health of the public; and

Whereas ISPE is firmly committed to providing an unbiased forum for the open exchange of scientific information among all parties with interests in drug development, drug delivery, drug use, drug costs, and drug effects; and

Whereas ISPE has a long-standing history of advocating for evidence-based decision making and policy development informed by rigorous scientific research; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the International Society for Pharmacoepidemiology (ISPE) officially endorses the nonpartisan, international March for Science and its mission, principles, and goals.
